- 5 years B.A.LLB (Hons.) and B.B.A,LLB (Hons.), Integrated Degree Course 2)

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

- The applicant who has passed the prescribed qualifying examination from recognized Boards of examination that are situated outside Karnataka or in a Foreign country shall compulsorily obtain the ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE before taking the admission.
 - Such candidates may apply by online (Seva Sindhu) for the Eligibility Certificates to the KSLU by paying necessary fees along with documents of 10th and 12th Std as applicable along with transcripts issued by the concerned Board or Department.
 - ✓ The Eligibility Certificate will be issued through online by the KSLU, Hubballi for those candidates who have obtained their qualifying certificate outside the Karnataka state and all the foreign candidates/applicants.

The qualifying certificates should be in Kannada or English only.



- All those candidates who have obtained qualifying certificate from outside the Karnataka state should produce the countersigned original certificates from the issuing authorities, otherwise eligibility will not be considered.
- The students who have studied qualifying examination +2 under C.B.S.E, Board, New Delhi are exempted from eligibility certificate for admission.
- Fees for Eligibility certificate for LL.B Rs.2200/- (Two thousand two hundred) for Indian students and Rs.11,000/-(Eleven thousand) for Foreign students and same should be paid by Online.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Instructions to the affiliated Colleges regarding the admissions to various classes of 5 year BA/BBA/B.Com., LL.B. and 5 year BA/BBA., LL.B. (Hons) Courses.

The applications for admission and the admission statement should be as per proforma prescribed by KSLU, Hubballi. The admission statements in Proforma-1 and 2, shall be forwarded to the KSLU on or before the dates specified in Academic Calendar 2021-22.

The eligibility for admission is as given below:

- (a) An applicant who has successfully completed Pre-University course or Senior Secondary School course ('+2') or equivalent such as (11+1, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving Certificate Course) from a recognized University of India or outside or from Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by the State Government or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course, may apply for and be admitted into the course.
- (b) Minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% (44.5% and above shall be treated as 45%) of total marks in case of General category applicants, 42% (41.5% and above shall be treated as 42%) for OBC category and 40% (39.5% and above shall be treated as 40%) of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.
- (c) <u>Maximum age</u> * for seeking admission is limited to 20 yrs (twenty years) in case of General category of applicants and to 22 yrs (twenty two years) in the case of applicants from SC, ST and Other Backward Communities as on 2nd August 2021.
- * A Writ Petition (civil) No. 1023/2016 pending before the Supreme Court of India regarding the maximum age limit prescribed for admission. The admission of the students who have crossed the age limit is subject to the outcome of the said writ petition. In this regard, college has to obtain an undertaking from the students who have crossed the age limit in the proforma enclosed.

Explanation:

Provided that the applicants who have obtained +2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate or First Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission to 5 year LL.B., course.

Provided further that the applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation or post-graduation through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission to the Law course.

All Subsequent years (classes) of all law courses:

- a) The Principal shall verify the promotional eligibility of the students for admission to next class/year of the course. In this regard, principal has to enclose the certificate stating that, the student has fulfilled the promotional eligibility criteria for the course.
- b) The admissions for subsequent years shall be made as per Admission Time Table 2021-22 by enclosing all previous semester marks cards.
- c) The Statement of admission in proforma-1 & 2 shall be submitted to the K.S.L.U. on the dates mentioned in Academic Calendar 2021-22 under sl.no.05.
- d) The Proforma no: 03 to 09, of consolidated admission statements in A4 size papers shall be bound into a single booklet along with the covering letter (with details of fee paid) & shall be addressed to the Registrar, Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi, and be submitted at the time of original document verification.
- e) Incomplete applications shall be liable to be rejected.

3) ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- a) Admission to the course shall be made strictly on the basis of merit. While making admission to be course reservation policy of the Government of Karnataka governing admissions to higher educational institutions issued from time to time shall be observed.
- b) 2 seats under supernumerary quota shall be reserved for the Jammu and Kashmir students within the sanctioned intake until the last date of admission as per the orders of Govt. of India.
- C) 5% of seats shall be reserved for the Kashmiri Migrants until the last date of admission as per the orders of Govt. of India, Dept. of HRD, New-Delhi. The persons claiming the status of Kashmiri Migrants should produce the identity card issued by the Jurisdictional Deputy Commissioner and District Magistrate of the Government of Karnataka to this effect.
- d) Reservation for Hyderabad Karnataka students under Art 371(J) as per rules shall be adhered to 8% of the seats shall be reserved for them.
- e) 3% of seats shall be reserved for physically challenged students as per rules applicable.
- f) 5% of seats shall be reserved for Gadinadu/horanadu Kannadiga (Those studied 1 to 10 std. in kannada medium from the outside Karnataka state)

4) FEES

- All Principals are strictly instructed to collect the fees as prescribed by the University and Government of Karnataka.
- b) The college shall apply to concerned District Social Welfare/BCM Department for the reimbursement of SC/ST/OBC student's fees.

5) INTAKE

No College shall admit the students in excess of the sanctioned intake.

6) THE COLLEGE AUTHORITY SHOULD VERIFY -

- a) The eligibility of the students as per BCI rules & KSLU admission regulations before admitting the students to the courses.
- b) The students shall be asked to produce the Migration and Transfer Certificates within one month from date of admission.
- c) In case of applicants from Foreign Universities/Boards, the applicant should have obtained the valid passport, visa, Residential permit, and "Students Study Permission/NOC" from Foreign Embassies of both the nations. They should also obtain a certificate that the degree is obtained from a recognized Board/University from the concerned embassy in India.
- d) In case of applicants from Foreign Universities/Boards, the applicant shall be asked to produce the "Equivalence Certificate" issued by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi if necessary.
- e) At the time of documents verification by University for admission approval, the college should submit the originals of above documents & 'Eligibility Certificate' (wherever applicable).
- f) The Principal of the college shall verify the original documents and attest the copies thereof.
- g) The Principal of colleges should certify that the admissions (for all classes) of course/s are made as per the admission rules of Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi and Government of Karnataka.
- h) In case a student is an employee either in State/Central/Private organization, he shall submit a study permission letter from concerned employer stating that the working hours do not conflict with college timings and the Principal should certify that the candidate is capable of attending 70% of classes.

7) THE COLLEGE AUTHORITIES SHALL ENSURE SUBMISSION OF THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS BY THE APPLICANT TO THE COLLEGE, AS BELOW.

- a) The Eligibility Certificate issued by the University, in case of Non-Karnataka and Foreign students at the time of admission.
- b) 10th Std. marks card & P.U.C./12th Std/H.S.C. or any equivalent examination marks cards in case of 5 years LL.B. admission, at the time of admission.
- c) The Transfer & Migration Certificates shall be submitted by student to the college at the time of admission or within one month from the date of admission to the college.
- d) In case of SC/ST/Cat-1/OBC student, Caste & Income certificate shall be submitted by student to the college at the time of admission.

- Soft copy Proforma No: 03 shall be submitted through email on very next date after closing the admission dates as mentioned in the academic calendar 2021-22 (caseworker.acad.kslu@gmail.com and kaksluacademic9@gmail.com)
- Consolidated admission statement in Proforma No: 03 along with admission applications with necessary attested documents to be submitted at the time of original documents verification.
- The Proforma No: 04 to 10, of admission statements along with the covering letter (with details of fee paid) addressed to the Registrar, Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi, and be submitted at the time of original document verification.
- Incomplete information in the Proforma will be rejected and admissions of the college will not be approved or may be withheld for want of information.
- The serial numbers of candidates in subsequent admission statements viz, Proforma III, shall be in continuation with the 1st of admission statement.
- Admission statement in proforma III should be prepared as per the date of admission serially, not in alphabetical order.
- Fees collected shall be remitted through online (State Bank Collect). The admission statements and the fees paid details shall be submitted to the Registrar, KSLU along with the Proforma No: 01 containing details of fees.

Note:

- 1) In complicated/doubtful cases, the principal of the college may seek clarification from the Academic Section.
- 2) The college/s shall admit the student/s only after verification of the necessary documents & eligibility certificate for fulfillment of eligibility criteria, as detailed in the K.S.L.U. Admission rules. In case any college admits in-eligible candidate/s to any course, the Principal will be responsible for further consequences in the matter of non-approval of such admission/s and the Principal is liable for a fine of Rs. 10,000/- for each of such admission.

Reservations for admission to the Educational Institutions as per Article 15(4) and Employment as per Article 16(4) of the Constitution of India and New Creamy Layer Policy Orders....reg.

Read:

- 1. G.O. No. SWD 150 BCA 94 Dated: 17-09-94
- 2. G.O. No. SWD 251 BCA 94 Dated: 31-01-95
- G.O. No. SWD 394 BCA 94 Dated: 14-02-96
- Letter No. KSCBC:MS/Reports/2000-01 Dated: 14-12-2000 of the Member Secretary Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes.

Preamble:

In Govt. Order Dated: 17-09-94 read (1) above, Govt. have formulated reservation policy for Schedule Casts and Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes for admissions to professional courses for the year 1994-95 as per the lists of castes enclosed thereto as follows:

CATEGORY-I	4%
CATEGORY-II (A)	15%
CATEGORY-II (B)	4%
CATEGORY-III (A)	4%
CATEGORY-III (B)	5%
SCHEDULED CASTES .	15%
SCHEDULED TRIBES	3%

- 2. Under the said order Dated: 17-09-94 it has also been stated that no person other than belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Category-I of Backward Classes shall be entitled to the benefit of reservation for admission to professional courses unless he/she satisfies the conditions of the creamy layer specified there under.
- 3. In G.O. Dated: 31-01-1995 reat at Sl. No. 2 above, the aforesaid reservation and creamy layer policy envisaged in the order Dated: 17-09-94 read at Sl. No. (1), has been made applicable to the employment too, under Article 16(4) of the Constitution of India.
- 4. In G.O. Dated: 14-02-96 read at Sl. No. (3) above the Creamy Layer Policy existed as on 01-01-95 for the purpose of admission to the professional courses was also made applicable to employment with retrospective effect from 01-01-94.
- 5. In Writ Petition No. 438/94 the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India have passed an interim order stating that the reservation in any case should not exceed 50%. Similar writs bearing No. 417/94, and 694/94 are pending disposal before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Therefore, in G.O. No. SWD 61 BCA 95 Dated: 28-12-95 the currency of the 50% reservation specified in G.O. Dated: 17-09-94 and 13-01-95 has been extended till the final decision in WP No. 438/94, 471/94 and 694/94 is taken by Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- 6. Now the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes have submitted special report and 71 advices vide their letter Dated: 04-12-2000 read at Sl. No. 4 above. Pending consideration of the entire report, the Government have examined in detail the Creamy Layer Policy contained in the Special Report and 71 Advices, relating to inclusions, deletions, correction of spellings etc. and have made the following orders.

Government Order No. SWD 225 BCA 2000, Dated: 30th March 2002

After careful consideration of the above proposal the Government are pleased to make the following orders:

- 1. The quantum of Reservation Specified in G.O. Dated: 17-09-1994 and 31-01-1995 read at Sl. No. (1) & (2) respectively is continued for admission to Educational Institutions and Employment.
- The revised list of Backward Classes enclosed to this order as at Annexure-I, incorporating recommendations of the BC Commission, is brought into force with immediate effect.
- 3. A new comprehensive Creamy Layer Policy as detailed in Annexure-II to this Government order is brought into force with immediate effect. This Creamy Layer Policy does not apply to SCs/STs and Category-I of the Backward Classes. Candidates belonging to Category-II(A), III(B), III(A), and III(B) shall be entitled to reservation in the manner specified in the new comprehensive Creamy Layer Policy.
